3) FSC134 – “Fitness and Conditioning for Firefighters” is a co-requisite. Even if you have previously completed this class, you will need to take FSC134 in conjunction with FSC102. (This is an advanced level of FSC134 and requires enrollment in the specific section, which is only open to FSC102 students. More information regarding the specific section number will be provided during the interview and at orientation).

4) CPAT - In order to be accepted into the Fire Academy, you will need to have passed a CPAT, or successfully completed FSC130-“CPAT” or pass an academy physical ability entrance test, which will be administered by the course instructors or their designee. A successful CPAT within six months from the start of the academy class will satisfy this prerequisite. Written documentation or other verification must be provided from the testing agency, e.g. college and/or fire dept, city or organization indicating successful completion of a testing process (placed on an eligibility list).

* **Prerequisites;** in order to be considered for the PVCC/PC Fire Academy, you must complete this application, have completed EMT104 and FSC105 with a grade of “C” or better, pass a CPAT or an academy physical ability entrance test, and complete an oral interview before the start of the academy. ***If selected, you will be notified when to register and enroll.***





*** Sponsorship is not required. PVCC and PC will provide you with most of the necessary equipment. Upon acceptance into the academy, you will be required to purchase the required textbooks, firefighter gloves, a nomex hood, work gloves, and the necessary recruit uniform. Purchasing information will be provided during orientation.*
